SOME SURVEY RESULTS



61% of parents, 66% of residents and 90% of school staff support the trial



70% of children want to travel to school actively, up from 37% who normally do



Only 14% of parents, 18% of residents and 16% of school staff think the street outside the school is safe

Parent/carer parking requirements:

Please do not park inconsiderately or illegally including:

- On footpaths or verges
- In front of people's driveways
- Where there are vehicle restrictions such as double yellow lines
- In an unsafe place such as junctions or crossings

Please consider walking, cycling or wheeling to school if you are able.

Alternatively, park further away in a considerate and legal place and walk the last part to school.
